For design problems, work to within 5% of specifications.

- 1. Design an example circuit with only passive components (L, R, C) to deomonstrate that it is possible to have gain > 1 without an amplifier at 1 kHz. Could this be done using only resistors and capacitors?
- 2. For a 2nd order filter described by the general formulae, what is the gain at $\omega = \omega_0$? Give the result for high pass, low pass, band pass, and band stop filters.
- 3. Draw the circuit of a Sallen-Key high pass filter. Show that Q = 1/(3-k) and $\omega_0 = 1/RC$ (same as for the low-pass version analyzed in the lecture).
- 4. Using the general expression for a 2nd order low pass filter with DC gain k=1, derive the formula given in the notes for the frequency of the $-3 \, \mathrm{dB}$ point:

$$\omega_{3dB} = \omega_0 \sqrt{b + \sqrt{1 + b^2}}, \quad \text{where} \quad b = 1 - \frac{1}{2Q^2}.$$

How does this expression change for a high pass filter?
