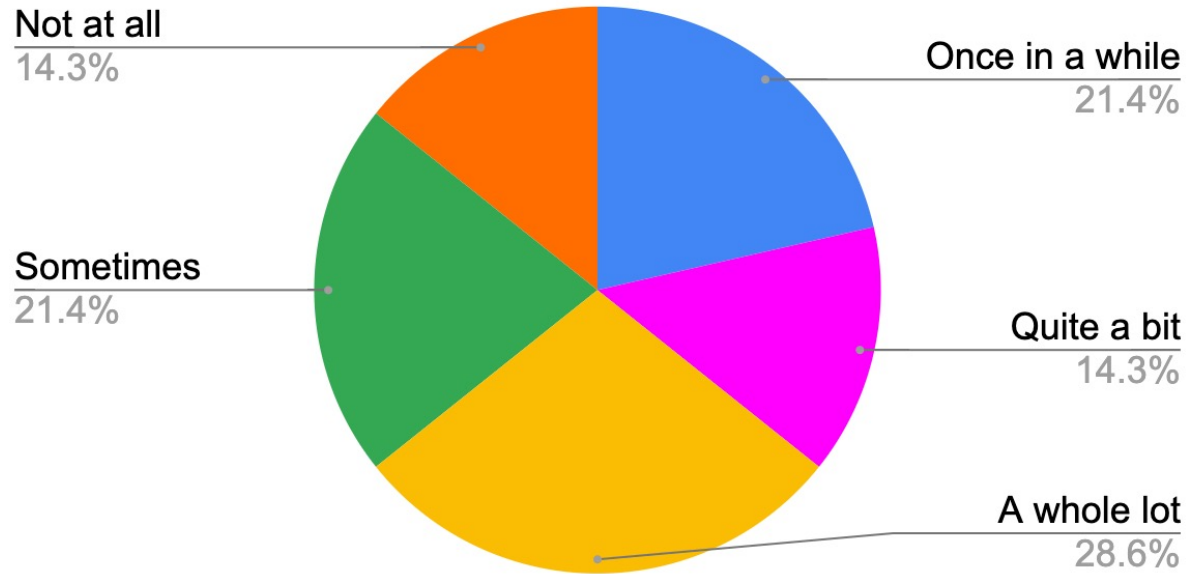

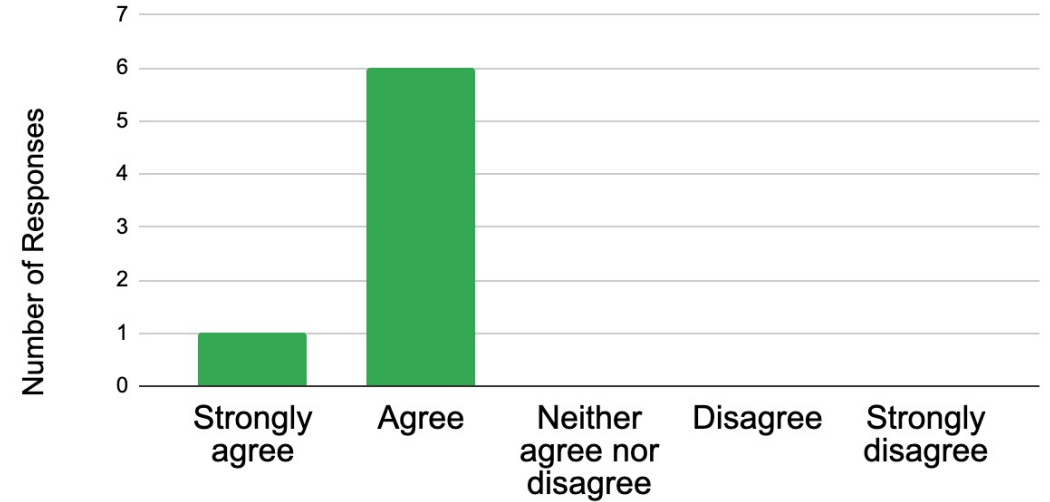

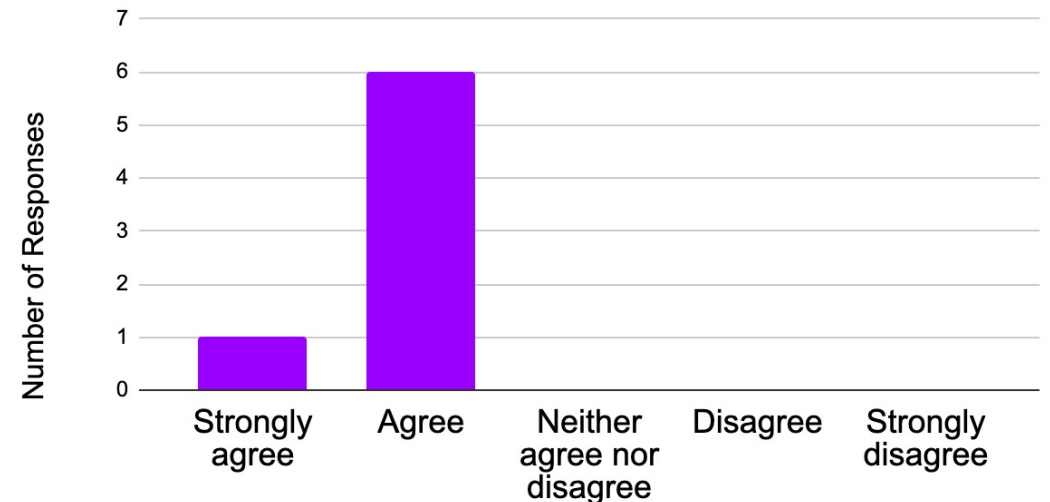
How often does your family do science stuff together?
