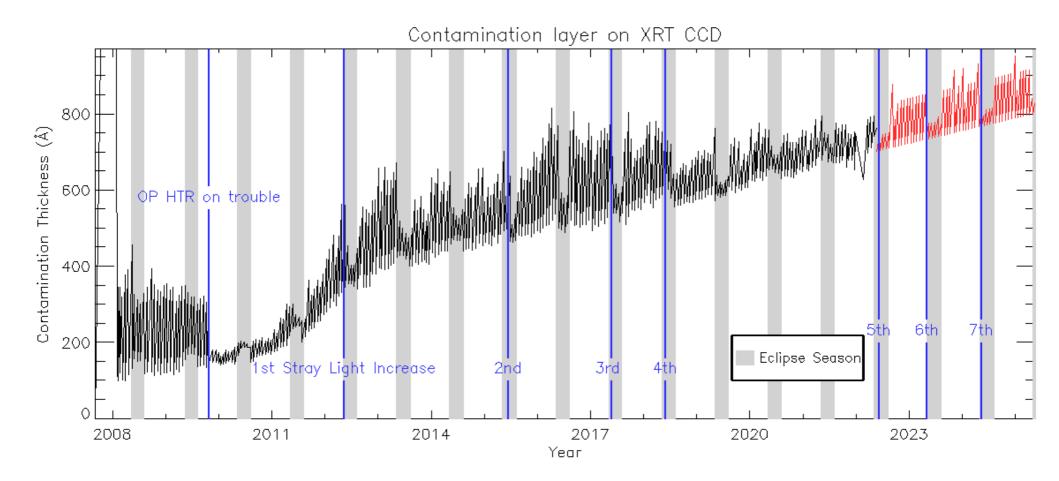
Long term plots of contamination thickness on CCD and roll angle + roll angle measurement using SUVI

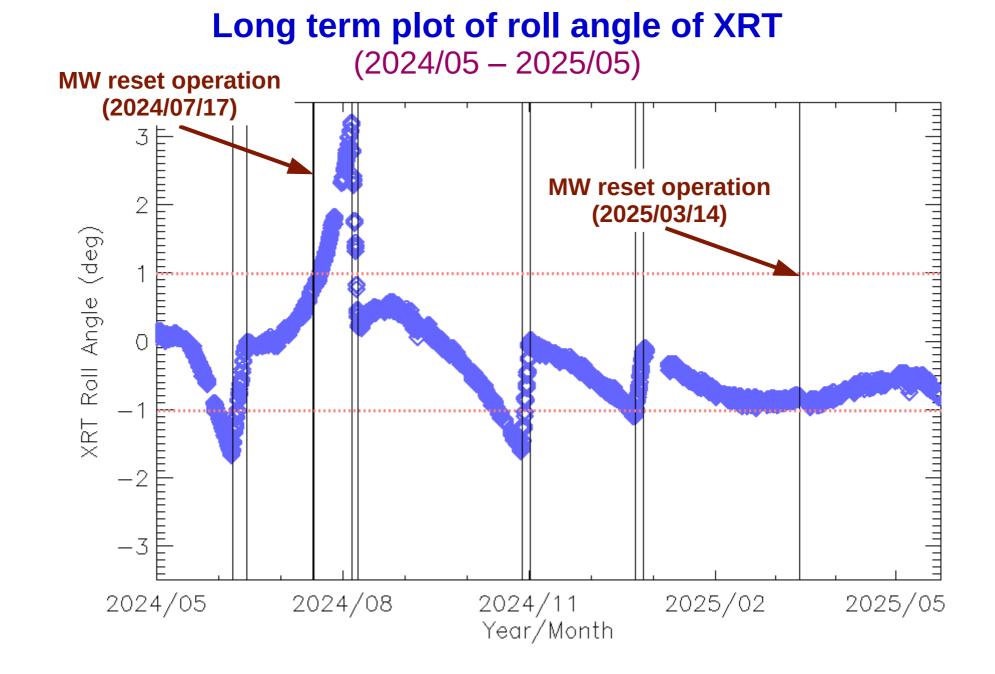

Impacts:

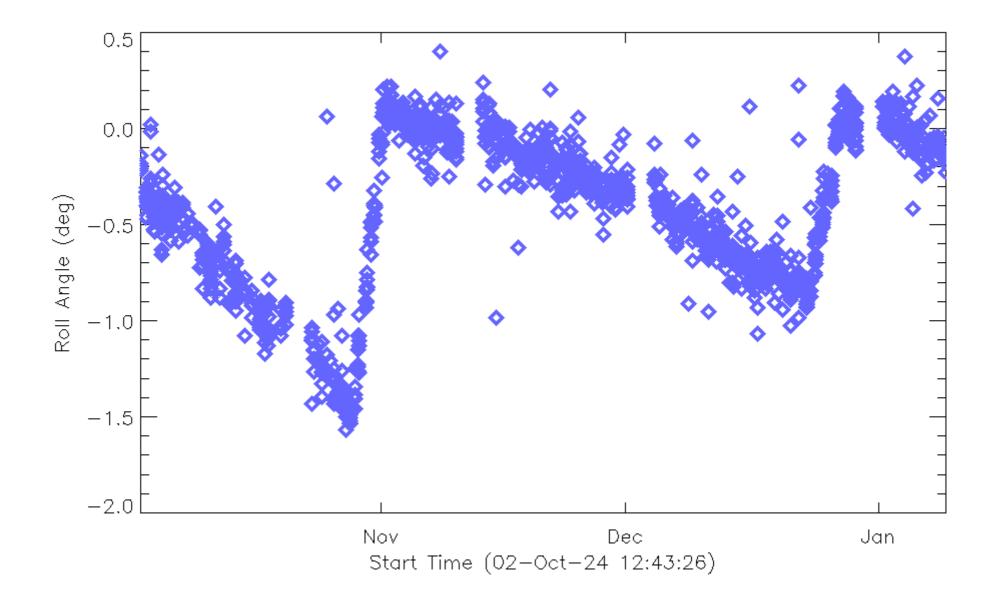
- Roll Angle monitor
 - \rightarrow Use SUVI data
- Roll Angle DB / Coalignment DB
 - \rightarrow Stopped processing until the JSOC recovery

Roll angle measurement using SUVI data

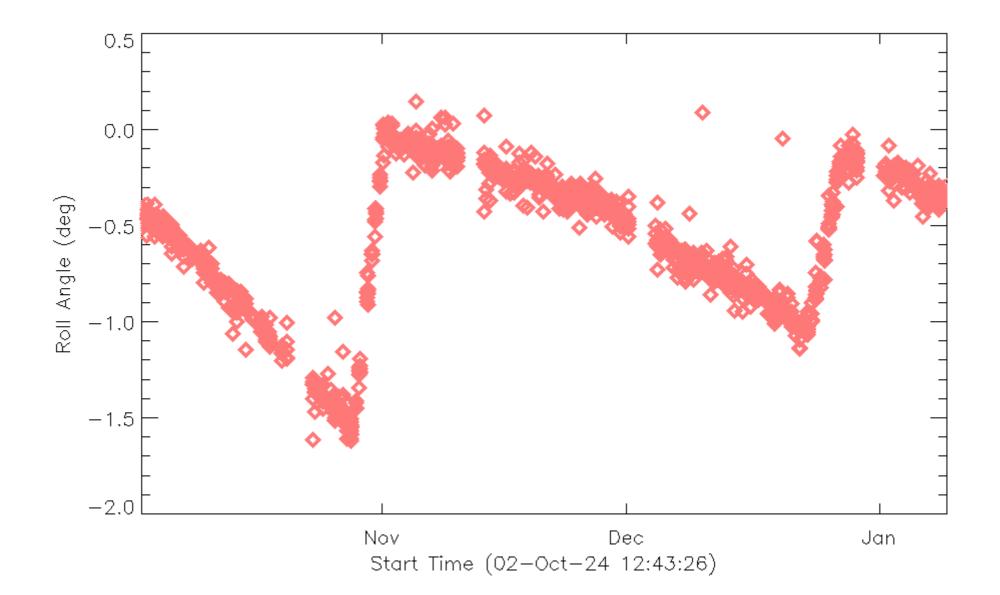
<u>Concerns:</u>

- No 335A image
 - using AIA 335A for the measurement when AIA data is available
 - comparing 284A image of SUVI with XRT's thin filter image is best
- No detail knowledge about the roll angle of SUVI

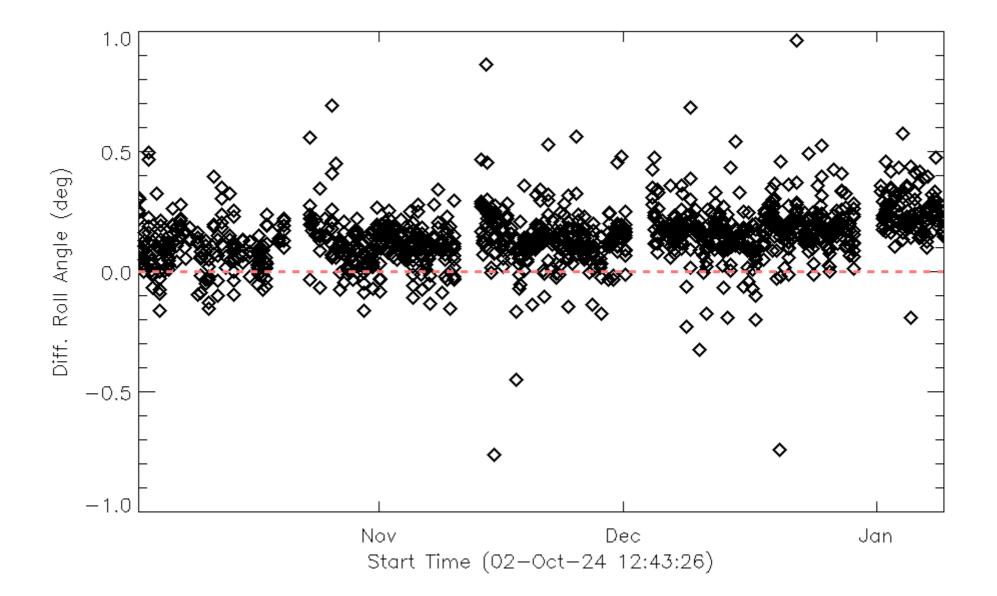
Using SUVI 284A data (θ_{SUVI})

Difference b/w the roll angles (θ_{SUVI} - θ_{AIA})



Roll angle measurement using SUVI data

<u>Results:</u>

- θ_{suvi} shows slightly larger scatter
- offset between θ_{SUVI} and θ_{AIA} exists
 - may be able to calibrate
 - may change in time

0.1 degree, for example, is not a trivial in some cases

 \rightarrow useful enough for monitoring purpose, but AIA is better choice
