## Homework Set \# 5

1. Due Wednesday, Feb 6 (Read $\S 2.2 .3$ ):
(a) Find the electric field inside and outside a sphere with uniform charge density $\rho$.
(b) Two identical spheres, radius $R$ and uniform charge density $\rho$, are centered at $x= \pm a$, where $a<R$. Where these spheres overlap, the charge density is $2 \rho$. Find the electric field everywhere. You may begin with the solution to 1 a .
2. Due Friday, Feb 8 (Read §2.3):
(a) For each of the following, either demonstrate that the electric field is impossible, or find the electric potential and the charge density. Note that $A, k, a, b$ are constants.
i. $\boldsymbol{E}=A y \hat{\boldsymbol{z}}$.
ii. $\boldsymbol{E}=A e^{-k r} \hat{\boldsymbol{r}}$.
iii. $\boldsymbol{E}=\frac{A \hat{s}}{s}$ for $a<s<b$, zero elsewhere.
(b) An infinitely long rod has radius $R$ and constant volume charge density $\rho$.
i. Find the electric field inside and outside the rod. Sketch the magnitude $E(s)$
ii. Let $V=0$ at the center of the rod. Find and sketch the potential $V(s)$ inside and outside the rod.
