Homework Set # 5

- 1. Due Wednesday, Feb 6 (Read $\S2.2.3$):
 - (a) Find the electric field inside and outside a sphere with uniform charge density ρ .
 - (b) Two identical spheres, radius R and uniform charge density ρ, are centered at x = ±a, where a < R. Where these spheres overlap, the charge density is 2ρ. Find the electric field everywhere. You may begin with the solution to 1a.</p>
- 2. Due Friday, Feb 8 (Read $\S2.3$):
 - (a) For each of the following, either demonstrate that the electric field is impossible, or find the electric potential and the charge density. Note that A, k, a, b are constants.
 - i. $\boldsymbol{E} = Ay\hat{\boldsymbol{z}}.$
 - ii. $\boldsymbol{E} = A e^{-kr} \hat{\boldsymbol{r}}.$
 - iii. $E = \frac{A\hat{s}}{s}$ for a < s < b, zero elsewhere.
 - (b) An infinitely long rod has radius R and constant volume charge density ρ .
 - i. Find the electric field inside and outside the rod. Sketch the magnitude E(s)
 - ii. Let V = 0 at the center of the rod. Find and sketch the potential V(s) inside and outside the rod.
