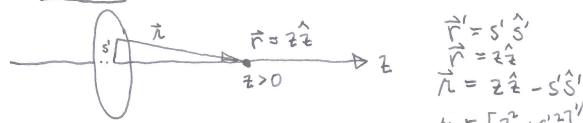
Let's return to this example and consider the case z<0.



EXAMPLE: UNFORMLY CHARGED DISK



$$\overrightarrow{E}(\overline{z}) = \frac{1}{4\pi E_0} \left(\frac{\sigma \hat{\Lambda} dq}{\Lambda^2} \right) = \frac{\sigma}{4\pi E_0} \int_{S=0}^{R} \frac{2\pi}{(z^2 + S'z)^3 / 2} \frac{\sigma(symmerry)}{(z^2 + S'z)^3 / 2}$$

The "signum" of z is defined as sgn(z) = z/|z|.

ANOTHER INTERESTING LIMIT: HOLD & FIXED R+00 OR Z+0:

$$\overline{E} = \frac{\sigma^2}{2E_0} \frac{\text{sgn}(z)}{\text{INFINITE SHEET OF CHARGE on 2!}}$$

WHAT IF $\frac{7}{6} < 0$? When we remove the constraint z > 0, we find a dependence on z through the signum function.
